APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

SUBSTRATE PREPARATION

No special treatment or cleaning is required when the intended use is for removing and stripping.

MIXING

This product requires no mixing, use straight out of the container.

APPLICATION

The customer is responsible for following the recommended application procedures. Failure to do so will likely result in unsatisfactory product performance. Always test the complete coating system **prior** to the start up of production. A patch test is recommended on an area not normally visible.

1. Safety

To avoid contact with skin and eyes, wear chemical resistant gloves and use a fresh air respirator.

2. Application

- Apply by brush.
- Allow 10 to 15 minutes to penetrate and lift old finishes.
- Remove old finishes with a scraper or putty knife
- Repeat procedure if necessary
- Brush with a stiff bristle-brush to remove paint residues.
- Clean surface with Goudey 788 lacquer reducer. If fish eye is a problem, clean the surface with 700, 706 or 707
- For hard to strip finishes (e.g. post catalyzed topcoats), rough the surface with 80 grit sandpaper before applying stripper.

Note: Goudey 770 is NOT recommended to use over fiber glass or plastic.

3. New finish preparation

Make sure there is NO residue of old finishes on entire surfaces.

PRECAUTIONS

Equipment

Goudey 770 is applied by brush.

Containers

Goudey 770 Paint & Varnish Remover should be stored in the original container or in a metal container with a secure lid.
